BIRTHPARENT SUPPORT

Our office number is answered 24/7. That means that every night one of the staff takes the phone lines. That night it was my turn. I got a call at 3am. It was Brandie*, a birth mom who had previously placed her child through our agency. She was having a hard time and just needed someone to talk to. I talked with her for about two hours at which point she confided thoughts of suicide and hung up the phone. I called the police to do a welfare check and ran to the office to find her address per their instructions. I was almost to the office when I got a return call from a police officer. They had found her safe and were going to spend some time with her before returning to their route. We received another call from Brandie a couple of days later, just letting us know she was doing well. Sometimes birthparent support isn't about adoption at all. What a blessing to know that God had placed Christian Adoption Services as a beacon of hope in Brandie's life.
